NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Class will apply for those fleets racing as a one-design class.
- 1.3 Certain rules may be changed and these changes will appear in full in the SIs.

2. **ADVERTISING** – Shall be in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20, Advertising Code, (no restrictions).

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1 This regatta is open to mono-hull and multi-hull boats with a valid PHRF, IRC (5 or more IRC boats required) and one design classes (5 or more boats required)
- 3.2 Entry fee is \$75.00 is postmarked by May 31, 2010. Entries postmarked after May 31, 2010 will be \$125.00.
- 3.3 Entry can be made by sending in the attached entry form and check to:

- 3.5 Entry is limited to 250 boats.

4. VENUE

- 4.1 The starting area will be in the vicinity between Pt. Knox and Yellow Bluff. The start will be a down wind start, one start only.
- 4.2 The finishing area will be off Spinner Island, NNW of Pittsburg on the Sacramento River. Distance is approximately 43nm.

5. **WARNING** – The Warning Signal for all fleets will be at 1030 hrs.

6. **SCORING** – One race is scheduled. The low point scoring system will be used. Handicap boats will be scored time on time.

7. **PRIZES** – In addition to class prizes, the following perpetual prizes will be awarded:

- 1. Farm Door Prize – First boat to finish regardless of class
- 2. Il Moro Trophy – First Mono-hull to finish regardless of class
- 3. Sausalito Cup – First overall on corrected time.

8. **SOCIAL** – A post race party will be held at Spinner Island. More information is provided on the entry form attached.
